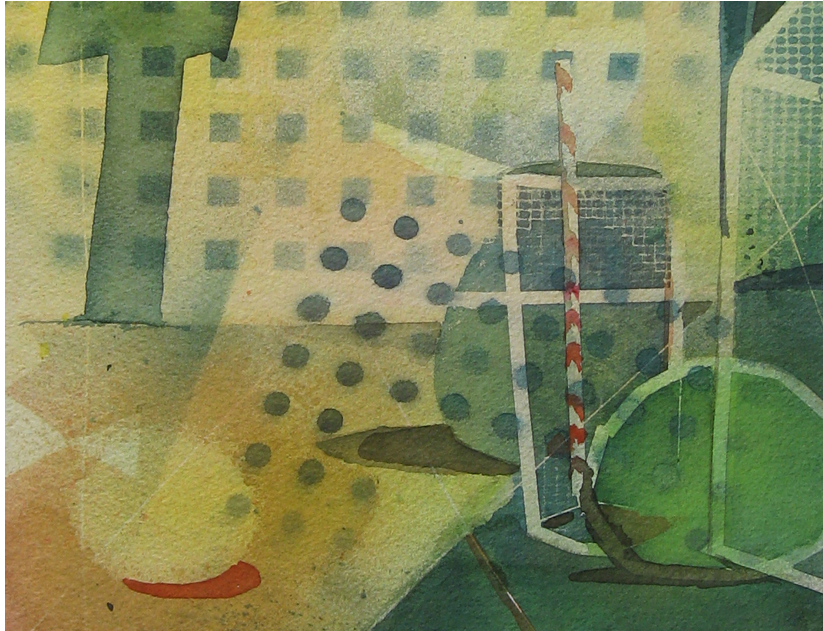


Tape & Spray Watercolor Workshop

MATERIALS LIST

Paints: At least one tube of each primary color: yellow, red and blue. Please be sure to have tubes rather than cakes of paint.

3 Brushes: one Round or Chinese brush, size 8,10 or 12, one- Flat 1/4-1/2 inch and one- Rigger

Paper: Two sheets Arches cold press watercolor paper 22x30 or smaller, 140 lbs. or heavier

Palette: 1 large flat palette

Misting Spray bottles, four or more small (travel size)

Tape (Green Frog brand seems to work best)

Utility knife,

Self-healing cutting board

What else might come-in handy?

Masking fluid, Pencil, Eraser, Extra brushes & paper, stencils, Sketch/note pad, Natural Sponge, Water jar, printed reference images, Ink pens, snacks, drinking water, apron.
